Storm and Hurricane Moisture Checklist

Before Conditions Worsen

- Charge phones and cameras for documentation.
- Know where the main water shutoff and electrical panel are located.
- Move important records and small valuables away from low areas when safe.

After the Storm - Safety First

- Do not enter areas with standing water near electrical sources.
- Avoid rooms with sagging ceilings, structural movement, gas odors, or damaged wiring.
- Contact emergency services, the utility provider, or another emergency resource when appropriate.

Document the Damage

- Photograph roof openings, stains, wet flooring, wall damage, and affected belongings.
- Record the date, approximate time, and suspected water-entry location.
- Save receipts for temporary coverings, emergency drying, and protective materials.

Next Steps

- Contact your insurer if you plan to make a claim.
- Ask about flood-versus-homeowners coverage and documentation requirements.
- Request provider availability for moisture inspection, drying, or mold-related concerns.
